To DSP, I miss our orchestra so, so much!

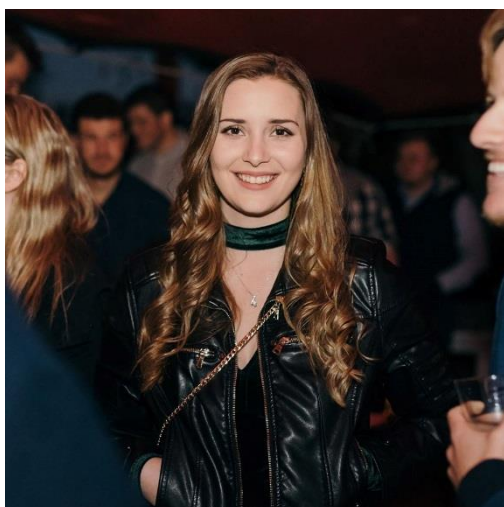
Tineke Sinovich – BA Law and LLB at the University of Pretoria
